5 Proposing an amendment to Article
6 III of the Constitution of the
7 State of Alaska relating to the
8 election of district attorneys.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Article III, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding
11 a new section to read:

12 "Section 28. District attorneys shall be elected as provided
13 by law. A district attorney shall be at least twenty-six years of
14 age and a qualified voter of the State. He shall be licensed to prac-
15 tice law in the State and shall have been a resident of Alaska at
16 least two years immediately preceding his filing for office."; and be it

17 FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed before the
18 voters of the State at the next statewide election in conformity with Sec-
19 tion 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
20 laws of the State.
