5 Relating to the location of fish pro-
6 tein concentrate manufacturing plant
7 at Sitka, Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the commissioner of the Food and Drug Administration has ap-
10 proved the use of whole fish protein concentrate as a food additive; and

11 WHEREAS Congress has recently passed legislation authorizing the con-
12 struction of one fish protein concentrate manufacturing plant and the leasing
13 of a second, locations to be determined by the Secretary of the Interior; and

14 WHEREAS Alaska is one of the greatest fishing areas of the world and as
15 such is an ideal and logical location for the operation of a fish protein
16 concentration plant; and

17 WHEREAS production of fish protein concentrate in Alaska would greatly
18 benefit the economy of the state;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior is respectfully re-
20 quested to locate one of the fish protein concentrate manufacturing plants
21 authorized recently by Congress in Sitka, Alaska.
