2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 37

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the Federal Uniform Time
6 Act of 1966.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the trade and commerce of Alaska would best be served by main-
9 taining the closest possible time relationship with the other West Coast
10 state; and

11 WHEREAS this would be most reasonably and efficiently accomplished by
12 Alaska remaining perpetually on daylight saving time in each of the three
13 time zones specified in the Uniform Time Act of 1966; and

14 WHEREAS this arrangement would also benefit the industry and travelling
15 public of the other forty-nine states;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that it is the desire of the Fifth Legislature of the
17 State of Alaska that the State of Alaska be exempt from those provisions of
18 the Uniform Time Act of 1966 which permit daylight saving time for only a
19 portion of each year.

20 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Alan S. Boyd,
21 Secretary of the Department of Transportation; the Honorable John W. Bush,
22 Chairman of the Interstate Commerce Commission; and to the Honorable E.L.
23 Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the
24 Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska
