2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 43

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Urging the development of harbor  
6 facilities adjacent to the city of  
7 Unalaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS adjacent to the city of Unalaska there is a landlocked harbor  
10 known as Margaret Bay on Amuknak Island; and

11 WHEREAS to make Margaret Bay a valuable harbor would require only the  
12 dredging of the entrance and the installation of the necessary moorage  
13 facilities; and

14 WHEREAS there is a great number of boats in need of these facilities;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS if this project at Margaret Bay can be surveyed and action  
17 taken immediately, it could be done at the same time as the King Cove project  
18 and thereby result in a great savings in time and money;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of the Army is respectfully requested  
20 to take immediate action to determine the requirements for and build a  
21 harbor at Margaret Bay.
