2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 54

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to community-wide pollution of
6 wells in Fairbanks and requesting as-
7 sistance from the Office of Emergency
8 Planning.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS, in the suburban areas of Fairbanks, a great many of the water
11 wells are still polluted as a result of the August 1967 flood; and

12 WHEREAS the Office of Emergency Planning is able under existing law to
13 give assistance in cases where the facility involved is designated as a com-
14 munity facility; and

15 WHEREAS the effect of the remaining well pollution is community-wide
16 and equivalent to the pollution of a community facility under the intent and
17 spirit of the existing law;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska requests the
19 Office of Emergency Planning to designate the polluted wells in the suburban
20 areas of Fairbanks as community facilities so that assistance might become
21 available under existing law.

23 Director of the Office of Emergency Planning; and the Honorable E. L.
24 Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable
25 Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in
