3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

5 To promote the building of
6 overnight facilities at
7 McKinley National Park.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the present overnight facilities at Mt. McKinley National Park
10 are inadequate to meet public demand during the tourist season; and

11 WHEREAS the lack of tourist accommodations have forced many persons to
12 abandon their plans to visit this great park; and

13 WHEREAS the impressions created in the minds of these tourists is an
14 integral part of tourism promotion; and

15 WHEREAS it is absolutely necessary that the tourist facilities at
16 Mt. McKinley National Park be upgraded and that additional modern overnight
17 facilities for tourists be provided; and

18 WHEREAS tourism is an important aspect of a healthy Alaskan economy;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urgently requests the
20 National Park Service to arrange for more adequate overnight facilities at
21 Mt. McKinley National Park.

23 Udall, Secretary of the Department of the Interior; The Honorable George B.
24 Hartzog, Jr., Director of the National Park Service; and to The Honorable

26 Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska
