5 Relating to the uniform fire and
6 police reporting telephone numbers.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, on November 1, 1967, Senator Ernest Gruening submitted a
9 resolution in the United States Senate in support of the adoption of one
10 uniform nationwide fire reporting telephone number and one uniform police
11 reporting telephone number; and

12 WHEREAS these universal numbers would hardly resolve the problems which
13 confront people in an emergency situation, but they do provide a workable
14 tool which can be regarded as a start in offering all citizens the emotional
15 security of knowing immediately how to get help in any crisis in any part
16 of the United States; and

17 WHEREAS this proposal deserves the support of all safety conscious
18 citizens interested in a simple and efficient way to improve the safety of
19 our society;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska endorses
21 Senator Gruening's proposal and recommends its national implementation.
