2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 65

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the establishment of Post
6 Offices at Little Russian Mission and
7 Kongiganak.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the villages of Little Russian Mission and Kongiganak are
10 presently without post office facilities; and

11 WHEREAS each of these villages has 70 or more permanent residents
12 with Little Russian Mission dependent on mail communication from Aniak
13 which is some 20 miles away and Kongiganak depending on mail communication
14 from Kwigillingok which is some 15 miles away; and

15 WHEREAS rapid postal communication is a necessity if a community is
16 to experience economic and population growth;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests the Post-
18 master General to provide post office facilities for these two villages.
