4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a commemorative statehood  
6 stamp.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Alaska will celebrate its tenth year since statehood in 1969;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS Alaska is the largest landmass state in the nation with the  
11 present potential of becoming the richest; and

12 WHEREAS no history of the United States is complete without considering  
13 the colorful and sometimes tragic part played by Alaskans from the "gold  
14 rush" to statehood; and

15 WHEREAS this state represents the last frontier of a comparatively new  
16 country in world history;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Fifth State Legislature respectfully requests  
18 the United States Post Office Department to issue a commemorative stamp in  
19 honor of Alaska's ten years as a full member of the United States.

20 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Lyndon B.  
21 Johnson, President of the United States; the Honorable Lawrence F. O'Brien,  
22 Post Master General, Post Office Department; and to the Honorable E. L.  
23 Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U. S. Senators and the Honorable  
24 Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in  
25 Congress.
