office at Coffman Cove, Alaska

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS communication facilities are essential for the development of

Alaska and the normal comforts of its population; and

WHEREAS the town of Coffman Cove, Alaska, has a population of over 200

11

people and is without a post office; and

WHEREAS Coffman Cove has great need of a post office because of the

13

requirements of its growing population and because of the location in the

14

area of a fish buying station, a state school, and three logging camps; and

WHEREAS there are a number of willing individuals in the town who are

16

capable of performing the functions of a postmaster;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General of the United States is

18

respectfully requested to establish a post office at the town of Coffman

19

Cove, Alaska.
