2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 80

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to airline excursion rates.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Alaska Airlines, Northern Consolidated Airlines, and Western
8 Airlines offer excursion rates to various points in Alaska which are cheaper
9 than regular flight fares; and

10 WHEREAS these lower fares facilitate more extensive utilization of air
11 transportation for tourists and businessmen; and

12 WHEREAS the present policy of these three airlines is that excursion
13 fare tickets cannot be exchanged between airlines without having to pay a
14 full fare upon transfer; and

15 WHEREAS it is in the public interest and the public good demands that a
16 passenger who has purchased an excursion ticket on one of the airlines should
17 be able to freely transfer to another airline offering an excursion fare
18 with no increase in the price of the ticket;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that Alaska Airlines, Northern Consolidated Airlines, and
20 Western Airlines are requested to change their transfer policy with regard
21 to excursion fares to allow transfers between airlines with no increase in
22 cost.
