4 FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

5 Requesting the Alaska Congressional Dele-
6 gation to introduce legislation to cover
7 Alaska shortfalls in revenue due to the
8 natural disaster of August 14, 1967.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the flood disaster of August 14, 1967, has had a grave impact
11 on state revenues and will continue to have an adverse effect for some time
12 in the future; and

13 WHEREAS it is of benefit to the entire nation that the Alaska economy
14 once again gain a disposition of vitality with as little delay as possible;
15 and

16 WHEREAS it will take several years for the State of Alaska to make up
17 for the shortfalls it has suffered in revenue and is sure to suffer in the
18 future due to the magnitude of this natural disaster;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska delegation in Congress is respectfully
20 requested to introduce without delay legislation which will have the effect
21 of directly relieving the burden of the above mentioned shortfalls in
22 revenue.

24 Johnson, President of the United States; the Honorable Carl Hayden, Presi-
25 dent pro Tempore of the Senate and Chairman of the Senate Appropriations

27 able George H. Nighan, Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee; and the
28 Honorable E. S. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators and
29 the Honorable Howard Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska
