5 Relating to the preservation and  
6 restoration of Alaska's vanishing  
7 historical sites and objects.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS the tourists who come to Alaska are always extremely inter-  
10 ested in the colorful and exciting history of the state; and

11 WHEREAS the year 1967 is the Centennial Year for the State of Alaska  
12 and a time when an exceptionally large number of tourists will be visiting  
13 the state; and

14 WHEREAS Alaska has not had an active program to preserve and restore  
15 its many famous historical sites and objects thereby allowing many of the  
16 great monuments and landmarks of Alaska's past to disappear or fall into a  
17 condition of deterioration and neglect;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to direct  
19 the Alaska State Council on the Arts to establish and carry out an active  
20 and continuing program to preserve and restore the vanishing historical  
21 sites and objects in Alaska and to recommend to the Second Session of the  
22 Fifth State Legislature legislation, if any, necessary to assure the  
23 success of such a program.
