5 Relating to the paving of one and one-  
6 half miles of the Steese highway.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the National Aeronautics and Space Administration has built an  
9 installation at Gilmore Sight in the vicinity of Fairbanks which employs  
10 256 persons and has a payroll of \$300,000 per month; and

11 WHEREAS it has been the policy of the Administration to employ local  
12 persons and have its personnel live, trade and become part of the community  
13 life of Fairbanks; and

14 WHEREAS Gilmore Sight has its own fuel system but does not use it as a  
15 matter of courtesy to boost the economy of Fairbanks; and

16 WHEREAS the highway between Fairbanks and Gilmore Sight is new but un-  
17 paved for a distance of one and one-half miles; and

18 WHEREAS this section of unpaved highway is rough and a great incon-  
19 venience to the employees living in Fairbanks and working at Gilmore Sight;  
20 and

21 WHEREAS if the highway remains in a rough and unpaved condition the  
22 Administration will open its fuel system and provide other services for its  
23 personnel which presently it allows the city of Fairbanks;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
25 the Department of Highways to pave the one and one-half mile section of the  
26 Steese highway from the Fox Store to Gilmore Sight at the earliest possible  
27 date.
