5 Relating to financial assistance to  
6 the City of Ketchikan.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the Barney Way Project, consisting of off-street parking  
9 facilities, a Centennial Building and street construction, is presently under  
10 construction by the City of Ketchikan at an estimated cost of \$1,080,000;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS when completed the Barney Way Project will not be as readily  
13 accessible as it should be for satisfactory use; and

14 WHEREAS the widening of Dock Street in the City of Ketchikan from the  
15 westerly end of the new Barney Way road to Main Street, a distance of one  
16 block, would provide ready access to the Barney Way area and would further  
17 provide for a smoother flow of traffic from one side of the business district  
18 to the other; and

19 WHEREAS the many needed improvements presently contemplated by the  
20 City of Ketchikan will create a financial burden; and

21 WHEREAS it is the understanding of the City Council that bond funds  
22 may be available in the State of Alaska for "off system roads";

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Ketchikan be given the sum of \$100,000  
24 from "off system roads" funds for the purpose of widening Dock Street in  
25 the City of Ketchikan from the westerly end of Barney Way to Main Street.
