5 Relating to the recent announcement  
6 by Alaska Steamship Company that it  
7 planned to discontinue service to  
8 the City of Cordova.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS the growth and development of not only the Alaska coastal  
11 communities but the entire state depends upon continued sea commerce; and

12 WHEREAS the City of Cordova is one of the communities in Alaska which  
13 is extremely dependent upon sea commerce and particularly on the shipping  
14 service presently rendered by the Alaska Steamship Company; and

15 WHEREAS the Alaska Steamship Company has recently announced that it  
16 intends to discontinue direct scheduled service to the City of Cordova; and

17 WHEREAS the discontinuance of shipping service to Cordova would severely  
18 damage the economic structure of the community and greatly hamper its future  
19 growth and development;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives protests the proposal  
21 of the Alaska Steamship Company to discontinue service to the City of  
22 Cordova.

25 the Honorable Warren G. Magnuson, U.S. Senators from Washington; and to the

27 and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Representative, members of the  
28 Alaska delegation in Congress.
