7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the West Anchorage Eagles, western Alaska basketball champions  
9 have met the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings, the southeast Alaska champions, to  
10 compete for the state basketball title; and

11 WHEREAS the Ketchikan Kayhi Kings defeated the West Anchorage Eagles  
12 this week in the best of a three-game competition, thus winning the 1968  
13 state basketball crown; and

14 WHEREAS the Kayhi Kings have been southeastern Alaska champions for  
15 five consecutive years and this is the fourth consecutive year the state  
16 basketball championship has been won by the Ketchikan team, a record never  
17 before equaled in the annals of Alaska basketball history; and

18 WHEREAS the West Anchorage Eagles fought hard for the title and demon-  
19 strated the best in good sportsmanship throughout the competition;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives extends to the  
21 Ketchikan Kayhi Kings and the West Anchorage Eagles its commendation on the  
22 winning of their regional titles; salutes both teams for the climactic state  
23 competition this week; and expresses its heartiest congratulations to the  
24 Ketchikan Kayhi Kings team and to head coach Claude Hunskor and assistant  
25 coach Robert Vincent for their victory in winning the state basketball crown  
26 for the fourth consecutive year.
