6 the Matanuska Airmen's Association.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS in recent weeks the citizens of Alaska again had cause to be
9 proud of and thankful for the men who serve in the Civil Air Patrol and in
10 other volunteer air search and rescue operations such as the Matanuska
11 Airmen's Association; and

12 WHEREAS these people have given tirelessly of their time and skills to
13 involve themselves in one of the largest and most widespread search efforts
14 in recent Alaskan history; and

15 WHEREAS their dedicated efforts were carried out most of the time under
16 extremely adverse weather conditions over some of the most treacherous
17 terrain in the state; and

18 WHEREAS the aerial search had its extra cost in terms of a downed rescue
19 craft which in turn was the object of an extensive search;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Fifth State Legislature commends the members of
21 the Civil Air Patrol, the Matanuska Airmen's Association, and the numerous
22 volunteers from all over the state who responded to the requests for search
23 assistance; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature expresses its gratitude on behalf
25 of the people of the state for their valiant efforts.
