7 over the death of Reverend
8 Martin Luther King, Jr.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

10 WHEREAS Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr. was a man with a dream, a
11 dream which included all men of all races; and

12 WHEREAS the history of the Civil Rights movement in this nation is
13 inextricably bound together with the history of Reverend King, the man and
14 the dream;

15 WHEREAS this dream will never be fully realized by him because of a
16 senseless and deplorable act of violence; and

17 WHEREAS, as recipient of the 1964 Nobel Peace Prize his name and deeds
18 were known throughout the world; and

19 WHEREAS Reverend King led a life which was a model of Christian love
20 and charity and one which if emulated by others would result in a better
21 world for all; and

22 WHEREAS Reverend King was a devoted husband and a kind and gentle
23 father to his children;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Fifth State
25 Legislature of the State of Alaska that this Resolution serve as an
26 expression of grief at the passing of Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr. and
27 as a token of sympathy to his wife, Coretta, and their children.
