6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to spouse's pension and survivor's
7 allowance under the Teachers' Retirement System."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.25.055 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.25.055. SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRIBUTION BY A TEACHER. If a
11 teacher is married or has a minor child or minor children and wishes to
12 make his spouse or minor child or minor children eligible for a spouse's
13 pension or survivor's allowance he may make a supplemental contribution
14 of an additional one per cent of his base salary commencing with the
15 second month [FIRST OF THE MONTH] following his first day of membership
16 in this retirement system, marriage, or July 1, 1967 [1966], whichever
17 is later. The contribution shall be deducted by the employer on the
18 basis of days taught at a daily rate determined by dividing the annual
19 contribution by 140.
