6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Nursing and its  
7 executive officer."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.68.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.68.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD OF NURSING.

11 There is created a Board of Nursing, consisting of five members  
12 appointed by the governor. Appointment to the board shall be based  
13 on an individual's qualifications, with secondary consideration being  
14 given to his geographical region in order to give representation to  
15 different areas of the state when possible [ONE MEMBER SHALL BE FROM  
16 NORTHWESTERN ALASKA, ONE FROM CENTRAL ALASKA, ONE FROM SOUTH CENTRAL  
17 ALASKA, ONE FROM SOUTHEASTERN ALASKA, AND ONE AT LARGE].

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.68 is amended by adding a new section to read:

19 Sec. 08.68.110. APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTIVE OFFICER. (a) The  
20 board may appoint and employ a qualified person not a member of the  
21 board to serve as executive officer of the board. The board shall  
22 define the duties and fix the compensation of the executive officer,  
23 and may employ other persons necessary to carry on the work of the  
24 board.

25 (b) The executive officer of the board shall have the same  
26 qualifications as a member of the board.
