5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act directing the secretary of state to conduct  
7 a poll of the people of the state regarding whether  
8 the borough form of government should be abolished."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. The secretary of state is directed to prepare a proposition  
11 to be placed on a separate ballot for submission to the electorate of the  
12 state in conjunction with the state general election of 1968, requesting the  
13 voters to indicate a "Yes" or a "No" on the proposition: "Should the  
14 borough form of government presently required under the state constitution  
15 be abolished?" The results of the poll shall be submitted to the legislature  
16 in January 1969, for the action it finds appropriate and necessary.
