6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring nonresident hunters to be accom-
7 panied by licensed guides."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.405. NONRESIDENT HUNTING GAME ANIMALS MUST BE ACCOM-
11 PANIED BY GUIDES. (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt,
12 pursue, take or import brown bear, grizzly bear, polar bear, sheep,
13 or walrus in or into this state, unless personally accompanied by a
14 person who is licensed as a master guide, registered guide or assistant
15 guide by the department.

16 (b) The nonresident who violates (a) of this section is guilty
17 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for
18 not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$2,500, or by
19 both.

20 (c) A resident who aids or abets a nonresident to violate (a) of
21 this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punish-
22 able by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not
23 more than \$2,500, or by both.
