6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring nonresident hunters to be accom-
7 panied by licensed guides."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.405. NONRESIDENT HUNTING GAME ANIMALS MUST BE ACCOM-
11 PANIED BY GUIDES. (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident ot hunt,
12 pursue or take brown bear, grizzly bear, polar bear, sheep, in this
13 state, unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed as a
14 master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the department,
15 or who is personally accompanied by a resident Alaskan over 19 years
16 of age who is the spouse of or is the spouse of or is related by blood
17 within and including the second degree of kindred.

18 (b) It is unlawful for a nonresident to import polar bear into
19 this state unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed as
20 a master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the department.

21 (c) The nonresident who violates (a) of this section is guilty
22 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for
23 not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$2,500, or by
24 both.
