6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring nonresident hunters to be accompanied
7 by licensed guides."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.405. NONRESIDENT HUNTING GAME ANIMALS MUST BE ACCOM-
11 PANIED BY GUIDES. (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt,
12 pursue or take brown bear, grizzly bear, polar bear or sheep in this
13 state, unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed as a
14 master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the department,
15 or who is personally accompanied by a resident Alaskan over 19 years
16 of age who is the spouse of or is related by blood within and including
17 the second degree of kindred. Any person who applies for a nonresident
18 big game tag for the taking of any animal specified in this section
19 shall first furnish to the state of Alaska, on a form provided by the
20 state, an affidavit showing that he will be accompanied in his hunt by
21 a person who is qualified under the terms of this section. Any person
22 who falsifies the required affidavit is guilty of perjury.

23 (b) It is unlawful for a nonresident to import polar bear into
24 this state unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed as
25 a master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the department.

26 (c) The nonresident who violates (a) of this section is guilty
27 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for
28 not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$2,500, or by
29 both.
