6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of dentists; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.36.220 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.36.220. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE BY RECIPROCITY. If an
11 applicant having the qualifications contained in secs. 110 and 210 of
12 this chapter has been engaged in the practice of dentistry for a
13 period of five [TWO] years in a state, territory, district or posses-
14 sion of the United States, immediately preceding his application to
15 practice in the state, the board shall license the applicant without
16 examination.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 08.36.280(a) is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

18 (5) agrees to become domiciled in the area for which the
19 permit is issued; and

20 (6) has not had a license to practice dentistry revoked,
21 suspended or annulled in another state, territory, district or
22 possession of the United States for any cause listed in sec. 310 of
23 this chapter.

24 * Sec. 3. AS 08.36.280(b) is amended to read:

25 (b) The board may authorize a temporary permittee to practice
26 dentistry in more than one city or rural village of the type specified
27 in (a)(2) of this section if the areas are geographically contiguous.

28 * Sec. 4. AS 08.36.280(c) is amended to read:

29 (c) The board shall annually renew a temporary permit upon

1 written application of an applicant and upon payment of the prescribed
2 if

3 (1) a resident licensed dentist is not practicing dentistry
4 in the same area as that for which the applicant's permit was issued;

5 (2) the applicant is domiciled in the area for which his
6 permit was issued;

7 (3) the applicant has been found by the board, after an
8 annual inspection of the quality of his services, to have adequately
9 assisted in servicing the dental needs of the area specified in his
10 permit; and

11 (4) the applicant has not committed an act which is a
12 ground for revocation in sec. 310 of this chapter.

13 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
14 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
