6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring resident tags for the hunting of
7 brown or grizzly bear and establishing a tag fee.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. PURPOSE. This Act is intended to conserve the species of
10 brown and grizzly bear by discouraging the incidental, unplanned hunting of
11 those big game animals in connection with hunting of other animals. The
12 legislature declares that the establishment of tag requirements for state
13 residents which are the same as those required of nonresidents for purposes
14 of brown or grizzly bear hunting will aid in conserving those big game
15 animals.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.340 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (18) Resident big game tags:

18 Brown or grizzly bear, each..... \$75
