6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the funding of teachers and  
7 teacher aides."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.17.040 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (4) the teacher aides' salary allotment (sec. 55 of this  
11 chapter).

12 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.17.050(d) is amended to read:

13 (d) Each district is entitled to the number of teacher units for  
14 elementary schools which corresponds to the average daily membership  
15 for its elementary schools in the following elementary schedule. Each  
16 district is entitled to the number of teacher units for secondary  
17 schools which corresponds to the average daily membership for its  
18 secondary schools in the following secondary schedule. If a school  
19 district has two or more secondary attendance centers, it shall sepa-  
20 rately compute the allowable number of teacher units for each of its  
21 secondary attendance centers which has an average daily membership of  
22 301 or more pupils. Each district is entitled to the number of teacher  
23 units for special education which corresponds to the average daily  
24 membership for its special education program in the following special  
25 education schedule.

(1) a school district with an average daily membership of 700 or more, or a school district with eight or more classrooms, is allowed a teacher unit for each building with eight or more classrooms, as an allowance for a principal for the building;

\* Sec. 4. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.17.055. TEACHER AIDES' SALARY ALLOTMENT. (a) Each district is entitled to the number of teacher aides based on the equivalent of one for every four teachers allowed under sec. 50 of this chapter.

(b) The allotment shall be 75 per cent of the actual expenditure for teacher aides up to the number of aides authorized, and may not exceed \$4,000 for each aide.

\* Sec. 5. AS 14.17.250 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(13) "teacher aide" means a staff member performing assigned activities primarily of a nonteaching nature which are not classified as professional educational, but which assist a staff member to perform professional educational teaching assignments.
