6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the penalty for driving a vehicle
7 without the owner's consent."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person who drives, tows away, or takes a vehicle not his
11 own without the consent of the owner, with intent temporarily to deprive
12 the owner of possession of the vehicle, or a person who is a party or
13 accessory to or an accomplice in the driving or unauthorized taking is
14 guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by imprison-
15 ment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000,
16 or by both. Upon conviction for a second or subsequent offense in
17 violation of this section, the offender's license to drive a motor
18 vehicle may be suspended for a period not to exceed three years and
19 this suspension is to be in addition to any other punishment fixed by
20 the court. The consent of the owner of a vehicle to its driving, towing
21 away, or taking shall not be presumed or implied because of the owner's
22 consent on previous occasions to the driving, towing away or taking of
23 the vehicle by the same or a different person.
