6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to special education teachers in the
7 Public School Foundation Program."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17.050(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The teacher salary average is the sum derived by dividing the
11 total amount which the district was required to pay to the full-time
12 and part-time teachers employed by the district in the year two years
13 before the fiscal year under the state minimum salary schedule, divided
14 by the total number of full-time teachers employed by the district in
15 the year two years before the fiscal year. If the legislature raises
16 the state minimum salary scale by a law effective during the fiscal
17 year, the teacher salary average is recomputed as if the new salary
18 scale had been in effect in the year two years before the fiscal year.
