6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the maximum length of salmon seine
7 vessels; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.10.115. MAXIMUM LENGTH OF SALMON SEINE VESSELS. A salmon
11 seine vessel may not be longer than 50 feet, official register length,
12 and 58 feet overall length except vessels that have fished salmon with
13 seines in waters of Alaska before January 1, 1962, as 50 foot official
14 register vessels. A person who violates this section is subject to the
15 penalties provided for in sec. 110 of this chapter.

16 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on May 15, 1967.
