6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the inclusion of employees of the
7 Pioneers' Home in the classified service; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 47.25.010(c) is amended to read:

11 (d) [(C)] The office of the governor [MAY EMPLOY THE NECESSARY
12 SUBORDINATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, AND] shall prescribe methods for
13 operation of the Pioneers' Home, standards of care and service to in-
14 mates [, AND RULES GOVERNING PERSONNEL AND REWARDING EMPLOYEES ON A
15 MERIT BASIS]. All employees of the Pioneers' Home are within the classi-
16 fied service under AS 39.25. An employee of the Pioneers' Home who
17 held his position on January 1, 1967, may be continued in his position
18 without examination if he meets the minimum qualifications for his
19 position and if he has been in state service for at least six months.
20 An employee who does not meet the minimum qualifications for his posi-
21 tion is subject to examination under AS 39.25 and the rules adopted
22 under that chapter.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 39.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

24 Sec. 39.25.125. PIONEER HOME EMPLOYEES EXCLUDED FROM PARTIALLY
25 EXEMPT SERVICE. The employees of the Pioneers' Home are not considered
26 to be employees of the office of the governor under sec. 120(5) of this
27 chapter.

28 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
29 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
