6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to civil liability for rendering
7 emergency aid; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 09.65.090. CIVIL LIABILITY FOR EMERGENCY AID. (a) Anyone
11 who, without expecting compensation, renders care to an injured or sick
12 person who appears to be in immediate need of aid is not liable for
13 civil damages as a result of any act or omission in rendering emergency
14 care or as a result of any act or failure to act to provide or arrange
15 for further medical treatment or care for the injured person.

16 (b) This section shall not preclude liability for civil damages
17 as a result of gross negligence or intentional misconduct. Gross
18 negligence means reckless, wilful, or wanton misconduct.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
20 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
