6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to veterinarians."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.98.050(3) is amended by adding a new subsection to
9 read:

10 (G) falsifies an official state or federal certificate
11 relating to veterinary medicine.

12 * Sec. 2. AS 08.98.210 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

13 Sec. 08.98.210. OUT-OF-STATE VETERINARIAN. A person who has
14 engaged in the licensed practice of veterinary medicine in a state,
15 territory, district or possession of the United States may be licensed
16 in this state without written examination if

17 (1) he meets the qualifications of sec. 170 of this chapter;

18 (2) he has engaged in licensed practice for five out of the
19 seven years immediately preceding the filing of his application;

20 (3) he first passes an oral examination by the board;

21 (4) the jurisdiction in which he holds his most recent valid
22 license extends the same privilege to those holding a license from this
23 state.
