6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fish and game license and tag
7 fees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) Fees for licenses and tags are as follows:

11 (1) Resident sport fishing license \$ 3 [5]

12 However, the fee is \$1 for a resident who is blind.

13 (2) Resident hunting license 5 [7]

14 (3) (A) Resident hunting and trapping license . . 7 [10]

15 (B) Resident trapping license 2 [3]

16 (4) Resident hunting and sport fishing license . . 7 [12]

17 (5) Resident hunting, trapping, and sport fishing

18 license 10 [15]

19 However, the fee is 25 cent for the head of a family or a dependent
20 member of his family or one solely dependent upon himself for support
21 upon proof presented by the applicant that the applicant (A) is
22 obtaining or has obtained assistance during the preceding six months
23 under any state or federal welfare program to aid the indigent, or
24 (B) has an annual family gross income of less than \$3,600 for the year
25 preceding application.

27 for a period of 10 days after date of issuance \$ 5

(9) Nonresident hunting and sport fishing

license. \$ 20

A nonresident may not take a big game animal without previously purchasing a numbered, nontransferable, appropriate tag, issued to him as provided in (16) of this section. The tag shall be affixed to the animal immediately upon taking and shall remain affixed until the animal is prepared for storage, consumed, or exported.

(11) Registered guide license. 25 [50]

(12) Assistant guide license 5

(13) Resident fur dealer and taxidermy license . . . 10 [20]

(14) Nonresident fur dealer and taxidermy license. 100

(15) Fish, fur or game farming license 5

(16) Nonresident big game tags:

Brown or grizzly bear, each 75

Polar bear, each. 150

Black bear or deer, each. 10

Bison, moose, or sheep, each. 50

Walrus, each. 50 [100]

Elk, goats, or caribou, each. 25

All nonresident big game tags are refundable and good for two years.

(17) Master guide or outfitter license 50

Sec. 2. AS 16.05.340 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(c) No resident hunting, trapping or sport fishing license fee is required for a person under 16 years of age.
