6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Federal Highway Safety Act of
7 1966; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.19.025. ADMINISTRATION OF HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAM. The
11 governor may contract and do all other things necessary on behalf of
12 this state under the Federal Highway Safety Act of 1966, and may
13 cooperate with federal and state agencies, private and corporate agen-
14 cies, interested corporations, and individuals, to effectuate the
15 purposes of that Act. The governor is the official in this state
16 having the ultimate responsibility for dealing with the federal govern-
17 ment with respect to programs and activities under the Federal Highway
18 Safety Act of 1966. He shall coordinate the activities of state de-
19 partments, agencies and subdivisions.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
21 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
