6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legal holidays."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal
10 holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the
11 twelfth of February, known as Lincoln's birthday; (3) the twenty-second
12 of February, known as Washington's birthday; (4) the thirtieth of March,
13 known as Seward's Day; (5) the thirtieth of May, known as Memorial Day
14 or Decoration Day; (6) the fourth of July, known as Independence Day;
15 (7) the first Monday in September, known as Labor Day; (8) the
16 eighteenth of October, known as Alaska Day; (9) the eleventh of Novem-
17 ber, known as Veterans' Day; (10) the twenty-fifth of December; (11)
18 every Sunday; (12) every day designated by public proclamation by the
19 President of the United States or the governor of the state as a legal
20 holiday or as a day of Thanksgiving; (13) every day on which a state-
21 wide election is held.
