6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the issuance of certain alcoholic  
7 beverage licenses; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.15.020(e) is amended to read:

10 (e) Churches and schools. The board shall not issue a beverage  
11 dispensary license or package liquor store license for the sale of [ANY]  
12 intoxicating liquor in any building in which the public entrance is  
13 within 200 feet of a school ground or church building measured by the  
14 shortest pedestrian route [DIRECT LINE] from the outer boundaries of  
15 the school ground or public entrance of a church building in which  
16 religious services are conducted, within or outside [WITHOUT] any  
17 corporate municipality nor for use [IN ANY BUILDING] within one mile  
18 [TWO MILES] of a state-owned [AN ACCREDITED] college or university  
19 where dormitories are provided. This distance shall be measured in a  
20 straight line from the central administrative building of the college  
21 or university. [CERTIFIED BY NORTHWEST ASSOCIATION FOR THE ACCREDITING  
22 OF INSTITUTIONS OF FORMAL EDUCATION.] A license may be reissued or  
23 transferred from one licensee to another, for the sale of intoxicating  
24 liquor in a building in which that sale was authorized by law on April  
25 25, 1960. When a license for the sale of intoxicating liquor in a build-  
26 ing within 200 feet of a school ground or church building in which  
27 religious services are conducted is forfeited, lapses or is transferred  
28 to other premises, no license for the sale of intoxicating liquor at  
29 the prior licensed location shall thereafter be issued. However, the

location may be relicensed in the event of the removal of either cause of the restriction.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
