5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public buildings, including
7 schools."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 58. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

11 Sec. 14.58.010. SCHOOL BUILDINGS. (a) The design of all school
12 buildings which require any state funds shall be functional. No
13 architectural frills which increase the cost of the building may be
14 permitted. An architect or contractor submitting plans for the con-
15 struction of or addition to a school building shall adhere to this
16 principle of function and shall not be permitted to receive a fee
17 for nonfunctional design elements. Submitted plans must be within
18 the amount of money available.

19 (b) When possible, building materials manufactured or processed
20 in the state shall be used.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 35.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

22 Sec. 35.10.012. FURTHER LIMITATIONS. No building design may
23 be approved which is not strictly functional, omitting architectural
24 frills which would increase the cost of the building. When possible,
25 building materials manufactured or processed in the state shall be
26 specified for use.
