6 **For an Act entitled: "An Act creating an advisory board for the Alaska**
7 **Pioneers' Homes."**

8 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

9 * **Section 1. AS 44.29 is amended by adding new sections to read:**

10 **ARTICLE 3. ADVISORY BOARD FOR THE ALASKA PIONEERS' HOMES.**

11 **Sec. 44.29.100. ALASKA PIONEERS' HOMES ADVISORY BOARD. There is**
12 **established in the Office of the Governor an advisory board for the**
13 **Alaska Pioneers' Homes.**

14 **Sec. 44.29.110. COMPOSITION. The advisory board for Alaska**
15 **Pioneers' Homes consists of five members appointed by the governor.**

16 **Sec. 44.29.120. QUALIFICATION OF BOARD MEMBERS. The members of**
17 **the advisory board shall be pioneers but need not reside at an Alaska**
18 **Pioneers' Home.**

19 **Sec. 44.29.130. TERM OF OFFICE. The members of the advisory**
20 **board serve at the pleasure of the governor.**

21 **Sec. 44.29.140. COMPENSATION, PER DIEM, OR EXPENSES. Members of**
22 **the advisory board receive no salary, but are entitled to per diem and**
23 **travel expenses authorized by law for other boards.**

24 **Sec. 44.29.150. DUTIES. The board shall act in an advisory**
25 **capacity to the superintendents of the pioneers' homes in matters**
26 **pertaining to the operation of the homes, and make a report each year**
27 **to the governor and the legislature on their operation.**
