6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to removal of vehicles from the state."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.620 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 28.10.620. REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM STATE. A person who  
10 removes from the state a vehicle which is the subject of a security  
11 interest created under the Alaska Uniform Commercial Code (AS 45.05.690  
12 - 45.05.794) without the written consent of the secured party is guilty  
13 of a felony, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not  
14 more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$2,000, or by both.
