6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to removal of vehicles from the state."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.10.620 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 28.10.620. REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM STATE. A person who
10 removes from the state a vehicle which is mortgaged, or is the subject
11 of either a conditional sales contract or a security interest created
12 under the Alaska Uniform Commercial Code (AS 45.05.690 - 45.05.794)
13 without the written consent of the mortgagee, the conditional sales
14 vendor or the secured party, and with the intent to defraud the
15 mortgagee, conditional sales vendor or the secured party, is guilty
16 of a felony, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for
17 not more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$2,000, or by
18 both.
