7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 28.10.620 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 28.10.620. REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM STATE. A person who  
10 removes from the state a vehicle which is the subject of a security  
11 interest created under the Alaska Uniform Commercial Code  
12 (AS 45.05.690 - 45.05.794) without the written consent of the secured  
13 party, and with the intent to defraud the secured party, is guilty of  
14 a felony, and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not  
15 more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$2,000 or by both.
