5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to organized borough school districts,
7 school boards and assemblies."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.12.025. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND
11 BOROUGH. (a) Subject to (b) of this section, the borough school board
12 shall have complete authority for the operation, maintenance, care,
13 custody, repair and rehabilitation of all school facilities, including
14 but not limited to school buildings, grounds and other school property
15 and facilities.

16 (b) The school board shall submit the annual budget for the
17 following school year to the assembly by April 1 for approval of the
18 total amount. Within 30 days after receipt of the budget the assembly
19 shall determine the total amount of money to be made available from
20 local sources for school purposes, and shall furnish the school board
21 with a statement of the sum to be made available. If the assembly does
22 not, within 30 days, furnish the school board with a statement of the
23 sum to be made available, the amount requested in the budget is auto-
24 matically approved. Not later than May 31, the assembly shall appro-
25 priate the amount to be made available from local sources from money
26 available for the purpose.

27 (c) The school board shall have complete authority for capital
28 programs for school facilities, including but not limited to the
29 preparation of programs, their submission to the assembly and to the

1 voters under borough election procedures, issuance and sale of bonded
2 debt, design of school buildings, selection of appropriate professional
3 personnel to develop designs, location, and construction of school
4 buildings. The board shall submit proposed capital expenditures to the
5 assembly for approval only of the total amount which may be expended
6 from local sources.

7 (d) The school board, in accordance with this title, shall have
8 complete authority for the appointment, compensation, and control of
9 all school employees and administrative officers and for formulation
10 and implementation of a school personnel system.

11 (e) The school board shall have complete authority for the deposit,
12 investment, management and accounting system for school funds.

14 Sec. 07.25.040. FUNCTIONS UNDER DIRECTION AND SUPERVISION OF
15 BOROUGH CHAIRMAN. The borough chairman shall direct and supervise the
16 administration of the following functions:

17 (1) the functions of all borough officers and employees
18 except as provided otherwise under this title and AS 14.12.025;

19 (2) the care and custody of all borough buildings and of all
20 real and personal property of the borough except as provided otherwise
21 by AS 14.12.025(a) [07.15.330(g)];

22 (3) the construction, ~~m~~aintenance, and operation of borough
23 roads, bridges, drains, buildings, and other public works, except as
24 provided otherwise in AS 14.12.025(a) and (c).

25 * Sec. 3. AS 07.25.030(1) is amended to read:

26 (1) except as otherwise provided by this title and AS 14,
27 appoint all borough employees and administrative officers and, when he
28 deems it necessary for the good of the service, suspend or remove any
29 borough employee, subject to review by the borough assembly, and any

1 borough administrative officer, but he may authorize any appointive
2 borough administrative officer to appoint, suspend, or remove subor-
3 dinates in that officer's department;

4 * Sec. 4. AS 07.25.030(3) is amended to read:

5 (3) except as provided otherwise for schools in AS 14.12.025,
6 prepare and submit the annual budget and capital program to the assembly
7 and execute the budget and capital program in accordance with appropria-
8 tions and ordinances adopted by the assembly;

9 * Sec. 5. AS 07.25.030(6) is amended to read:

10 (6) if the assembly provides for a personnel system, serve
11 as the personnel officer of the borough and administer the borough
12 personnel system, except for the school system, unless the assembly
13 authorizes him to appoint a personnel officer to administer the system;

14 * Sec. 6. AS 07.15.330(a) is amended to read:

15 (a) Each organized borough constitutes a borough school district
16 and the first and second class borough shall establish, maintain, and
17 operate a system of public schools on an areawide basis as provided in
18 AS 14.

20 Sec. 14.14.065. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND CITY.
21 The relationships between the school board of a city school district
22 and the city council and executive are governed in the same manner as
23 provided in sec. 25 of this chapter [AS 07.15.330] for the school board
24 of a borough school district and the borough assembly and executive.
