6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of voting machines in
7 state and local elections; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 15.20.230 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 15.20.230. AUTHORIZATION AND REQUIREMENT OF USE. Voting
12 machines may be used in any election, and shall be the exclusive method
13 of voting in all elections, whether statewide or local, in precincts
14 having over 150 voters and located in a city or borough having a popu-
15 lation of 10,000 or more.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 15.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17 Sec. 15.20.235. PURCHASE OF MACHINES AND RENTAL TO LOCAL GOVERN-
18 MENTS. (a) The state shall purchase voting machines for use in state-
19 wide elections in cities and boroughs having a population of 10,000 or
20 more and for rental to cities and boroughs for use in city or borough
21 elections conducted in cities or boroughs having a population of
22 10,000 or more.

23 (b) The number of machines provided in (a) of this section shall
24 be: one machine for each precinct having 150 to 350 voters and two
25 machines for each precinct having 350 voters or more. In either case,
26 the number of machines which have been provided in any other manner
27 shall be deducted from the total.

28 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
29 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
