6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the annual and sick leave of state
7 employees; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.20.240 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 39.20.240. ACCUMULATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE. The annual leave
11 which is not used by an officer or employee accumulates for use in
12 succeeding years until it totals not to exceed 60 days at the end of
13 the [LAST COMPLETE MONTHLY PAY PERIOD IN A] calendar year.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 39.20.260(e) is amended to read:

15 (e) Upon his separation from state service, and unless he re-
16 enters employment of the state within one year of his termination, the
17 unused sick leave of an officer or employee is automatically cancelled
18 without pay for it. If an employee once terminated re-enters the state
19 service within one year after his termination he is entitled to credit
20 for the sick leave he had accrued at the time of his termination.

21 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1967.
