5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to competitive bid requirements."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 37.05.230(1) is amended to read:

9 (1) a contract for construction and repairs, or a purchase
10 of and contract for supplies, materials, equipment, and contractual
11 services must be based on competitive bids; an award shall be made
12 to the lowest responsible bidder after advertising for bids, except
13 that

14 (A) the commissioner of public works may directly
15 negotiate a renewal or extension of a concession agreement or a
16 lease involving a concession agreement, whether or not exclusive,
17 for business operations at fixed locations at state-operated
18 airports under regulations adopted under the Administrative
19 Procedure Act (AS 44.62);

20 (B) a bid shall be awarded to an Alaska bidder if his
21 bid is not more than five per cent higher than the lowest nonresi-
22 dent bidder's; and

23 (C) competitive bids need not be required

24 (i) for contractual services where no competition
25 exists;

26 (ii) for sales involving fair trade items;

27 (iii) when, in the judgment of the purchasing
28 agent, food, clothing, or medical supplies, or materials for
29 use in laboratory and experimental studies may be purchased

1 otherwise to the best advantage of the state;

2 (iv) where rates are fixed by law or ordinance;

3 (v) for items traded in on like items; [OR]

4 (vi) for professional services; or

5 (vii) for air charter contracts involving two,
6 three, four, five or six place rotary-winged or fixed-winged
7 aircraft if 50 hours or less are needed in an area where two
8 or more air taxi operators are based;
