6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the photographing and micro-
7 filming of public records."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 40 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 18. PRESERVATION OF PUBLIC RECORDS.

11 Sec. 40.18.010. PHOTOGRAPHING AND MICROFILMING PUBLIC RECORDS.

12 A state agency or political subdivision may have any or all public
13 records kept by it photographed, microfilmed, microphotographed or
14 reproduced on film. These reproductions, except for records which are
15 treated as confidential under law, shall be made, assembled and indexed
16 in lieu of any other method provided by law, in a manner that the
17 governing body of the state agency or political subdivision considers
18 appropriate.

19 Sec. 40.18.020. PHOTOGRAPHED OR MICROFILMED COPIES CONSIDERED
20 ORIGINAL RECORDS. All photographs, microfilms, photographic film or
21 microphotographs provided for in sec. 10 of this chapter shall be con-
22 sidered to be an original record for all purposes, including intro-
23 duction in evidence in all courts, or administrative agencies. A
24 transcript, exemplification or certified copy of an original record
25 shall be considered to be a transcript, exemplification, or certified
26 copy of the original record for all purposes.
