FIFTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the limitation of regulatory power over contract carriers."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 42.10.080 is amended to read:

Sec. 42.10.080. REGULATORY POWER OVER CONTRACT CARRIERS. (a)

The commission shall

- (1) supervise and regulate every contract carrier in the state;
- (2) fix, alter, and amend just, fair and reasonable classifications, rules, regulations and minimum rates and charges of each contract carrier;
- (3) regulate the accounts, service, and safety of operations of every contract carrier;
- (4) require every contract carrier to file reports and other data; and
- (5) supervise and regulate every contract carrier in all other matters affecting its relationship with shipping and the general public.

(b) The commission shall not fix minimum or maximum rates and charges for contract carriers to perform construction hauling of dirt, rock, gravel, sand or other similar material.

(c) The commission shall not require certificates of convenience and necessity to perform services referred to in (b) of this section.
