6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of a program
7 for assistance for housing and related facilities for
8 Alaska Natives and other Alaska residents who are
9 unable to finance such housing; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. The governor is authorized to prepare a state housing
13 program for submission to the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development
14 pursuant to Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966).
15 Such program shall provide housing and related facilities for Alaska natives
16 and other Alaska residents upon terms and conditions they can afford.

17 * Sec. 2. The program shall:

18 (1) specify the minimum and maximum standards for such housing
19 and related facilities (not to exceed an average of \$7,500 per dwelling
20 unit);

21 (2) to the extent feasible, encourage the proposed users of such
22 housing and related facilities to utilize mutual and self-help in the con-
23 struction thereof; and

24 (3) provide experience, and encourage continued participation,
25 in self-government and individual home ownership.

26 * Sec. 3. The governor is authorized to designate an agency of the
27 state or a public corporate authority of the state to carry out this pro-
28 gram. The designated organization may accept grants or apply for and
29 receive loans under Title 10, Section 1004(A), Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat.

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1285 (1966).

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage or on the day it becomes law without approval.
